I, , attest that:

1. The organization is requesting to provide voter registration services at a USCIS naturalization ceremony;
2. The organization is a "bona fide nonprofit" organization that is exempt from federal tax requirements as described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (IRC) of 1986;
3. The organization will not participate in any political activity (such as: any activity directed toward the success or failure of a political party, candidate for partisan political office, or partisan political group; or advocacy for particular referenda or other political proposition), partisan or otherwise, at the ceremony, regardless of the physical location of the ceremony and whether the ceremony takes place on federal or nonfederal property;
4. The organization's staff have received training on how to register voters;
5. The organization will not engage in religious or commercial solicitation or promotion of any kind at the ceremony;
6. The organization will not discriminate on the basis of sex, race, color, gender identity, religion, age, sexual orientation, national or ethnic origin, disability, marital status, or veteran status when providing voter registration services;
7. The organization will safeguard all personal information new citizens provide for voter registration;
8. The organization will not collect, retain, or share the personal information of those registered to vote at naturalization ceremonies, even if this information is requested on a voluntary basis for purposes other than voter registration;
9. The organization will not use the information provided on voter registration applications for any purpose other than voter registration;
10. The organization will not alter completed voter registration materials in any manner;
11. The organization and its staff will dress in a professional attire and wear name tags that include the name of the organization while registering voters; and
12. The organization and its staff will adhere to all scheduling and logistical requirements set forth by USCIS field leadership and participate in an on-site briefing regarding rules for the facility where the administrative naturalization ceremony is scheduled to occur.
